

Domestic Violence and Restraining Orders

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE may occur in many forms between two people in an intimate relationship. Physical violence includes kicking, punching, shoving, slapping or any action that hurts your body. Sexual violence includes unwelcome touching, fondling or forced intimacy. Free Online Option to Fill Out the Forms to Request a Domestic Violence Restraining Order

The San Bernardino Superior Court offers you this free online program to fill out the forms to request or respond to a Domestic Violence Restraining Order. This program will NOT fill out the forms for a Civil Harassment Restraining Order. (Civil Harassment applies when there is no romantic or close family relationship between the parties.)

You will be asked a series of questions about your situation. Be sure to answer each question, since ALL the information is needed to fill out the forms completely.

Depending upon your situation, it may take you from 15 minutes to 2 hours to answer all the questions. If you have children and are asking for child or spousal support and want to fill out the Income & Expense Declaration online, the process will take you in the range of 2 hours.

If you create an account, you can save your answers and come back to it at any time. Creating an account is NOT REQUIRED to use the program. Be Safe! People can tell what internet sites you have visited on your computer.

Please note that the system will time you out at 2 hours, possibly without a warning. If you have created an account, your answers will be saved. However, if you did not create an account, then you will have to re-do your work.

At the end of the questions, you will be able to print your completed forms to take to the courthouse for filing. You can also easily email the forms to someone to print them out for you. There is no electronic filing of the forms at this time.

How to Use This Domestic Violence Restraining Order Request Program

Answer these questions in order to fill out your Restraining Order forms. If you answer each question, then your forms will be complete.

If you skip over any questions, it may take longer to get your forms filed at the courthouse. The clerk may have to return the pages to you, so you can finish the paperwork.

How To Use The Program:

At the bottom of each page, you can move to the next screen (or go back to the prior screen) after you have answered the questions. (NEXT or PREVIOUS)

If you see a "?" near the question, you can click on it to reveal some helpful information.

When you finish all the screens, you will select FINISH. You will need to print out all the forms and take them to the courthouse. Currently, there is no way to send your forms to the courthouse electronically.

If you created an account when you started on the LawHelpInteractive page, then you can stop at any time and save your work. (Select "Finish" at the bottom right to take you to the saving page.)

When you are ready to work on it again, you would use the account and password that you created to get your old answers back. (Keep your password safe!)

NOTE: The program will time out in 2 hours or less, so it is always recommended to create an account. Before you invest any time now, why not go back and create an account?

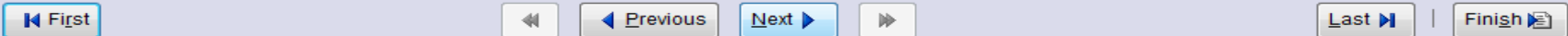

E. DESCRIPTION OF ABUSE: Most Recent Incident Of Abuse

The judge can make a restraining order **ONLY** if you give enough information to show that John Doe abused you or your child.

Abuse means:

- to hurt or try to hurt your body, either on purpose or by being reckless. Reckless means not careful;
- to make you or someone else afraid of being seriously hurt very soon. This fear must be reasonable;
- to bother, attack, hit, stalk (follow), sexually assault, threaten, batter, harass, telephone, or contact you; or
- to destroy your personal property. Personal property is a thing like your car, computer, phone, or things in your house.

On what date did the most recent abuse happen?

June 9, 2014

Who was there? (Identify the names of the person(s) who were present, whether or not they saw anything. Later, you will be asked about who are the "witnesses" to the incident.)

Bob Smith and Phyllis Smith

What did John Doe do to you?

John yelled at me, threatened to kill me, and then hit me across the face with his hand. I fell down to the ground and John came over and put his boot on me to keep me down.]

STEP #1 Paperwork Instructions - Your Options

Option 1: If you sent your forms by the internet to the courthouse.

1. SIGN your paperwork & keep this copy:
 - o DV-100 Request for Domestic Violence Restraining Order -bottom of Page 5 of 5.
 - o Certificate of Assignment-at bottom. On the line above, write in the date of signature and the city where signed.
 - o DV-108 Request for Order: No Travel With Children -bottom of page 2 of 2.

You will only have this form if you answered the questions about a risk of child abduction.
2. GET your court date information from the website or an email (if you gave address). Move on to the next step.

Option 2: If you are going to file your paperwork in person at the courthouse.

1. READ through the forms and verify the information. Make any changes in BLACK INK. Do not use white out. Just cross out the wrong information, initial and make the correction.
2. Anything you attach to the forms becomes part of the PUBLIC RECORD. If the photographs or records are private, you may wish to bring them to the hearing with you instead of attaching.
3. SIGN your paperwork:
 - o DV-100 Request for Domestic Violence Restraining Order -bottom of Page 5 of 5.
 - o Certificate of Assignment-at bottom. On the line above, write in the date of signature and the city where signed.
 - o DV-108 Request for Order: No Travel With Children -bottom of page 2 of 2.

You will only have this form if you answered the questions about a risk of child abduction.
4. Check the court's website for hours of the courthouse. Be sure to allow yourself enough time to get your paperwork processed.
5. TAKE your printed forms to the courthouse/family law window to get your emergency hearing date. There is no fee. Move on to the next step.

Advantages of E-Delivery

*You can send the forms from a safe location at any time of the day or night.

*Saves you one trip to the courthouse and time spent in line at the clerk's office.

How to E-Deliver

- ☞ **Step 1:** Save your domestic Violence Restraining Order Request forms as a PDF file. Save them on your computer or on a portable flash drive with a name you will remember.
- ☞ **Step 2:** Go back to the Court's website at www.sb-court.org for the Domestic Violence Page. You will see the link for Sending Your Forms Over the Internet.
- ☞ **Step 3:** Follow the instructions to submit your documents
- ☞ **Step 4:** Wait for clerk's office to process and set hearing date. Notification by email or check website later in the day.
- ☞ **Step 5:** Go to your hearing at court as scheduled.

Requesting a Hearing Date

Uploading the file

Follow the steps below to send your paperwork to the courthouse over the internet:

Step 1: Click the BROWSE button and choose the file name of the document you just created and saved for your domestic violence restraining order case. If you used a flash drive, you will retrieve your document from the flash drive. Whichever document you choose is the one that will be e-delivered to the Court.

Step 2: Click the UPLOAD FILE button.

Step 3: Click on the PRINT FILE button. Sometimes, it may take several seconds for your computer to process and get your documents ready for printing. Sign the forms and be sure to keep them. Your documents contain instructions about the process and how to serve the other party. **You will also find your "Declaration Regarding Ex Parte Notice" form which you will need to fill out and bring to your first hearing.**

Step 2: Click the UPLOAD FILE button.

Step 4: Click on the SUBMIT DOCUMENT TO COURT button. You will immediately see a confirmation response that includes a unique identification number for your paperwork. The unique identification number will allow you to access your hearing information once your papers have been processed by the court and the hearing date has been assigned. When you come back to this website, you will select "Retrieve Hearing Details" and enter this confirmation code.


