SAN BERNARDINO, CA—San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) is excited to deploy electronic filing (eFiling) for civil and landlord-tenant (eviction) cases, effective Monday, October 2, 2023. Although eFiling is strongly encouraged for attorneys and the public, at this time, it is voluntary. Those who prefer to continue to file in person, by FileSubmit, or through the mail, can continue to do so.

In alignment with its Strategic Plan, expanding access to justice by employing technology continues to be a key focus for the court. Additional technological improvements continue to provide positive impacts to our community by increasing services that can be accessed remotely and minimize on-site visits for court services. In conjunction with the eFile Civil / Landlord tenant go-live, the court is providing access to civil-unlimited complaints and eminent domain complaints that have been submitted for filing using eFile. This access will be available on the Court Access Portal (CAP) once court users complete the required registration for the service.

“We are very excited to continue expanding access to justice to better serve our community,” said Presiding Judge R. Glenn Yabuno. “We remain committed to improving our services and ensuring the court continues to be a reliable resource for all.”
